WISCONSIN BREWS

Spotted Cow

Cream Ale - 4.8% ABV \$6

New Glarus Brewing Company, New Glarus

Fun, fruity and satisfying farmhouse ale. You know you're in Wisconsin when you see the Spotted Cow. Available only in Wisconsin.

Ouisconsin Red Ale

American Amber/Red Ale - 4.8% ABV \$6

Central Waters Brewing Company, Amherst

Named for the Algonquin word for the Wisconsin River. Makes everyone want to be a Badger! Smooth amber ale with mellow nutty flavor and subtle flowery nose is sure to become a longtime favorite.

Bitter Woman

American IPA - 5.75% ABV \$6

Tyrannena Brewing Company, Lake Mills

Intensely bitter with a mighty hop flavor and aroma. Brewed to remember "Aunt Cal," the never-wed early resident of Lake Mills. Enjoy this Wisconsin variation of an India Pale Ale while toasting to the bitter woman you know!

Luna Stout

5.8% ABV \$6

Hinterland Brewery, Green Bay

Opaque, black, coffee-like character, infused with nitrogen. Very creamy, extremely clean and refreshing.

Miller Lite

Light Lager - 4.17% ABV \$3.50

Founders Porter - 6.5% ABV \$6

Founders Brewing Company, Michigan

This robust porter pours silky black with a creamy tan head.

The nose is sweet with a strong chocolate and caramel malt presence. Cozy like velvet, it's a lover, not a fighter.

FOREIGN IMPORTS

Stella Artois - 5.2% ABV \$6

Stella Artois Brewery, Leuven, Belgium

Mild golden lager, balanced in hops and grains

Slight citrus notes. Extremely drinkable.

Guinness Draught - 4.1% ABV \$6

Guinness Ltd., Ireland

Ruby and cream, black and white. Two distinct parts; one perfect pint. Adored since 1959, it's the powerful surge and settle that gives this beer its uniqueness.

Heineken Lager - 5% ABV \$6

Heineken Nederland B.V., Netherlands

Mildly bitter taste; fresh, fruity aroma. Bright color and exceptional clarity are obtained using only the purest water.

Clausthaler Premium - .45% ABV \$6 non-alcoholic

Binding Brauerei AG, Germany

Fresh floral hops with sweet, grainy malts. Creamy on the palate, sweetness is balanced by a moderate bitterness. Fresh and easy to drink.

Lindemans Framboise

Raspberry Lambic - Fruit - 2.50% ABV \$12

Brouwerij Lindemans, St. Pieters Leeuw-Vlenbeek, Belgium

Long before hops were common in most beers, various fruits and vegetables were used to season beers. The acidity of Lambic blends perfectly with raspberries.

Snow Day Winter Ale

American Black Ale - 6.2% ABV \$4.50

New Belgium Brewing, Colorado

Enjoy the unexpected. Pleasantly hoppy, carrying subtle chocolate and caramel flavors of a new brewing malt known as Midnight Wheat.

Bold and hoppy, drinkable and strong.

Sláinte

Scotch Ale - 7.5% ABV \$5

Central Waters Brewing Company, Amherst, WI

Expect this beer to be malt forward, brewed with cherry wood-smoked malt, with just a hint of peat-like smoke in the finish.

Cabin Fever

Pale Wisconsin Honey Bock 6% ABV \$4.5

New Glarus Brewing Company, New Glarus, WI

This pale bock is brewed with an exclusive blend of Wisconsin two-row barley. Naturally sweet clover honey was added to the kettle, accenting warm flavor notes.

Erdinger Pikantus 16.9oz

Weissebock - 7.3% ABV \$9

Erdinger, Germany

A delicacy to be enjoyed in the colder months of the year.

A dark bock beer with a sharp and full flavor.

Blue Moon Valencia Grove Amber

5.9% ABV \$4.5

Coors Brewing Company, Colorado

Deep copper amber in color with roasted caramel malts and touch of orange peel. Medium to full-bodied ale.

Beck's Sapphire

Pilsner - 6% ABV \$5

Bremen, Germany

Brewed with German saphir hops for a distinctively smooth taste.

Full-bodied, premium pilsner brewed according to the German Purity Law of 1516.

Henry Weinhard's Private Reserve

American Pale Lager - 4.8% ABV \$3.50

Blitz-Weinhard Brewing Company, Oregon

German heritage blended with natural ingredients of the Pacific Northwest. Brewed with 100% Cascade hops specially grown in Oregon.

Ayinger Bräu Weisse 16.9oz

Classic Bavarian Unfiltered Wheat Beer - 5.1% ABV
